Camp will be held June 1 - 5, 2020. Monday through Thursday hours are 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. On Friday, hours will be 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and campers will have an opportunity to share their artistic creations, and a light lunch, with parents. A small, nut-free snack will be served each day during our breaks, so it is very important that we know of any allergies our campers may have. That information can be provided in the registration packet.

Art Camp is for children aged four years through rising 6th graders. Four year olds should have preschool experience and be potty trained. There are volunteer opportunities for older children and adults.

Early Bird Registration for St. Barnabas church members and their families begins February 9, and Regular Price Registration for Friends of St. Barnabas begins March 1st. Please fill out the entire registration packet and return it, with your \$50 deposit, to Erika McCoy or the church office as early as possible. Scholarships are available for St. Barnabas members.

The remaining camp fee is due to the church office by April 26. We limit enrollment to 40 campers to ensure maximum fun and safety. If we run out of space, registration will close, and additional registrants will be placed on a waiting list in the case of cancellations. Out of respect for the limited number of spots, please only register your child if they are available for the full five days.

A welcome letter and a detailed schedule of each day's activities will be provided prior to the start of camp. Specific questions about activities, timing, or other details about the days will be addressed more accurately at that point, but we welcome any questions you have now. A list of our camp planning committee members is below, and they would be happy to field any questions.
